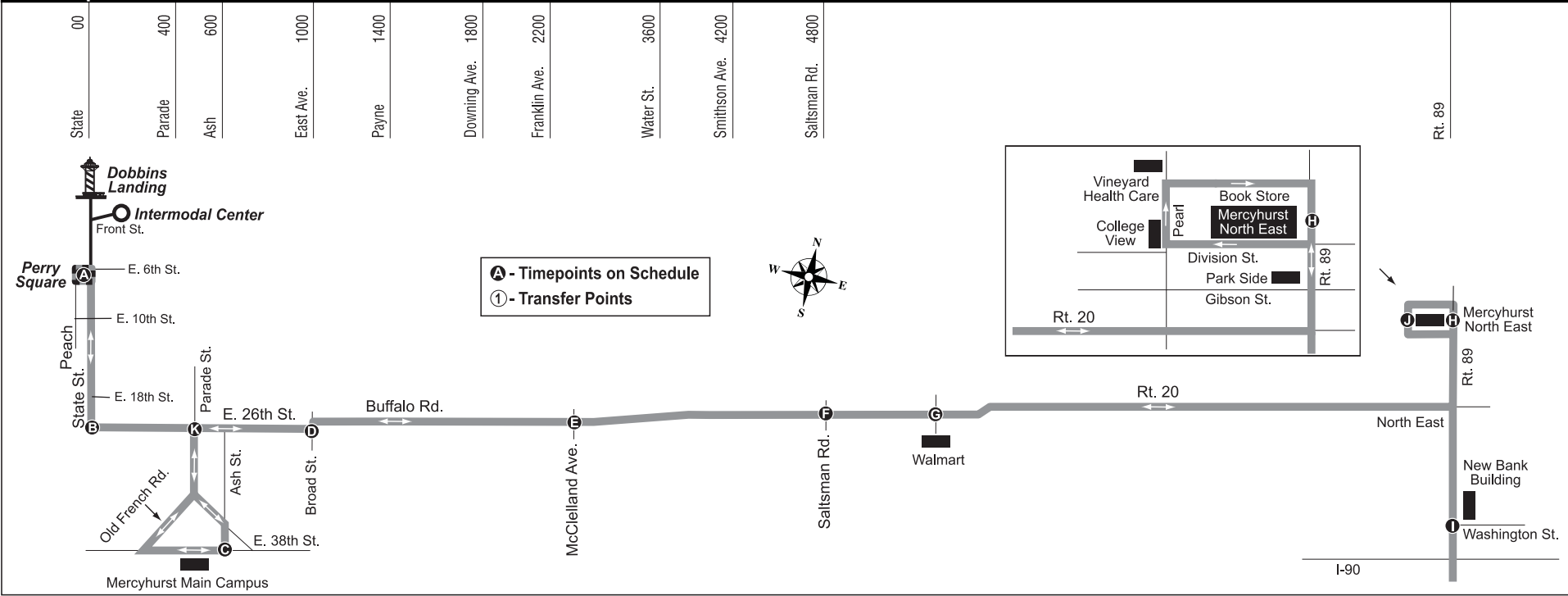

Perry Square to Mercyhurst North East to Perry Square

Leave Perry Square, south to 26th, east to Parade, south to Old French Rd., to 38th, east to Mercyhurst entrance. East to Ash, north to Pine Ave., to Parade, north to 26th, east to Broad St., to Buffalo Rd., to Rt. 20, east to front entrance of Wal-Mart, thru lot back to Rt. 20, east to Rt. 89, north to Division St., west to Pearl St., north to first entrance of Mercyhurst North East, east to Miller Hall Book Store. East to Rt. 89. South on Rt. 89 to New Bank Building (Rt. 89 to I-90),

return north on Rt. 89 to Division St., west to Pearl St., north to entrance of Mercyhurst North East, east to Book Store. East to Rt. 89, south to Rt. 20, west to front entrance of Wal-Mart, to Buffalo Rd., west to Broad St., south to 26th, west to Parade, south to Pine Ave., to Ash. South on Ash to 38th, west to Mercyhurst to Old French Rd., north to Parade to 26th, west to State, north to Perry Square.

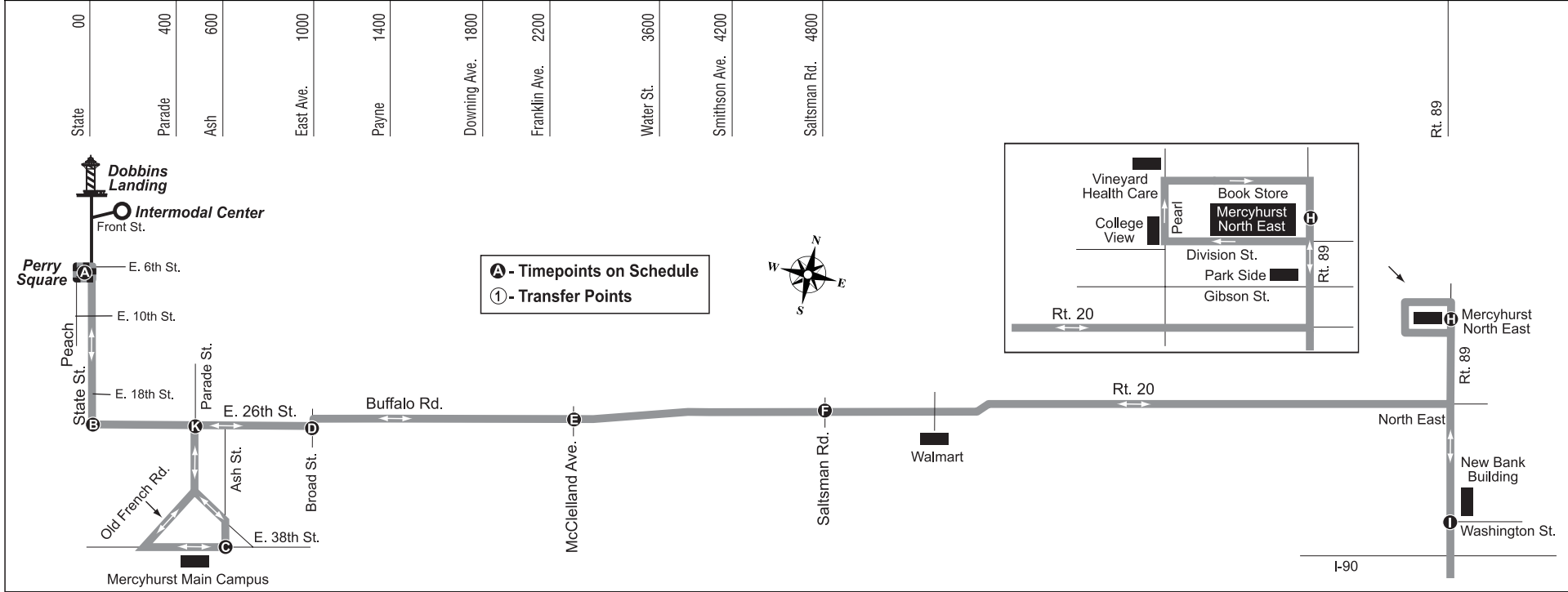

Trip 1 and 2
Perry Square to Mercyhurst North East to Perry Square

NOTE: TRIP 1 TO MERCYHURST NORTH EAST CAMPUS AND NEW BANK BUILDING (Rt. 89/Interstate 90)

Leave Perry Square, south to 26th, east to Broad, north to Buffalo Rd., east to Rt. 89, north to Division St., west to Pearl St., north to entrance of Mercyhurst North East, east to Book Store. STOP. East to Rt. 89. South on 89 to New Bank Building (Rt. 89 and I90). Return north on Rt. 89 to Division St., west to Pearl St., north to

entrance of Mercyhurst North East, east to Book Store. East to Rt. 89, south to Rt. 20 and Buffalo Rd., to Broad St. South to 26th, east to Parade, south to Pine Ave., south-east to Ash. South on Ash to 38th, west to light at Mercyhurst. West to Old French Rd., north to Parade to 26th, west to State, north to Perry Square.
